By continuing to work with Ontario Tire Stewardship to advocate responsible consumer tire recycling and highlighting the performance and environmental attributes of products made with recycled rubber, Multy Home and OTS are able to drive market change that creates even greater opportunities for the company. Over the years, the company has found an innovative use for the more than 12 million scrap tires produced in Ontario each year.

Multy Home is partnered with several major retailers across North America to offer its al-

ternative green flagship product, envirotile™ to consumers. Products such as envirotile™ and Multy Home's recently released Stomp Stone™ require simple installation and are made from environmentally safe recycled rubber materials. In fact, envirotile™ was recently dubbed one of the 'best new products' by U.S. home improvement expert, Danny Lipford. As a result of its recycled rubber composition, Multy Home's products are durable and weather resistant, do not leach toxins and also have greater capacity to absorb noise and shock.
