Every product claimed for an Incentive must have been pre-assigned a valid OTS "Product Code" that are specific to the RPM/U. The onus is on the applicant to demonstrate to OTS that the proposed product warrants the incentive(s) requested. OTS reserves the right to deny any application for incentives. OTS also reserves the right to require participant to provide additional information to supporting this application and/or claims submitted thereafter which may include 3rd party reports validating results at the request of OTS. Attach separate document(s) if needed.

SECTION 3 – Eligibility Requirements for NMECI

NMEC are products that are *New Manufactured Products which are Moulded, Extruded or Calendared* and are *substantially new or use a substantially new manufacturing process* (compared to existing products/processes at the time of application). The NMEC Incentive is available on an ongoing basis, although it is time-limited for any one particular product; the product will, however, receive the **MEC** Incentive on an ongoing basis. NMEC products are defined in 2 subcategories:

NMEC1 – applies to products produced using a substantially new manufacturing process;

- New process delivers significant improvements such as product costs, performance, profitability, and environmental footprint over the existing process.
- One year NMEC incremental incentive is available (then reverts to MEC eligibility only)

NMEC2 – applies to new products that meet a market opportunity not previously met using a recycled rubber or fiber product by a Canadian manufacturer or a product that has been substantially reformulated to include greater than 25% increase in fiber or rubber content;

• Two years NMEC incremental incentive is available (then reverts to MEC eligibility only)

To be eligible for **NMEC**, the product or the manufacturing process must be deemed "<u>Substantially New</u>" by meeting at least one of the following criteria:

a) Will the **new** product meet a market opportunity not previously met using a recycled rubber or fiber product by a Canadian manufacturer?

If yes please answer the following points below:

- Who are your potential customer segment(s)? Provide company names as examples if available.
- The specific needs that need to be met.
- The size of the market.
- Your capacity to capture market share.



b) Will an <u>existing</u> product be re-formulated to increase recycled rubber or fiber weight by >25% and improve product characteristics?
